The term "personal data" refers to personally identifiable information about you, such as your name, birth date, e-mail address or mailing address, and any other information that is identified with you personally, including your individual health information.

Notification of Changes to This Policy.

Personal Data Collected Through www.merlinmalta.com.

The only personal data Merlin Computers Ltd. currently collects through its websites is the information you voluntarily give us when you use our sites.

Use of Personal Data Collected Through www.merlinmalta.com .

- (i) personal data is not kept for a period longer than is necessary, having regard to the purposes for which they are processed.

Personal data may be processed only if:

- (a) the data subject has unambiguously given his consent; or
- (b) processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract; or
- (c) processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which Merlin Computers Ltd. is subject; or

- (d) processing is necessary in order to protect the vital interests of the data subject; or
- (e) processing is necessary for the performance of an activity that is carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in Merlin Computers Ltd. or in a third party to whom the data is disclosed; or

Anonymous Data Collected Through www.merlinmalta.com .

In addition to the information you provide when you use our websites, Merlin Computers Ltd. uses technology to collect anonymous information about the use of our websites. - (a) actual information about the data subject which is processed;
- (b) where this information has been collected;
- (c) the purpose of the processing;
- (d) to which recipients or categories of recipients the information is disclosed; and

(e) knowledge of the logic involved in any automatic processing of data concerning the data subject.
